Why do I need a Submittable account?

- You will need to create a free Submittable account to submit your Rec & Ed Scholarship application.
- Submittable is a software used by thousands of organizations to build customized online submission and application forms, as well as to review submissions and communicate with submitters.

How do I create a FREE Submittable account?

- Sign into your Submittable account
- You will see the Rec & Ed Scholarship application homepage
- Click the "Sign Up" tab
- Enter the following information:
 - Email Address & Confirm Email Address
 - Password & Confirm Password
 - o First & Last Name
- Click the blue Sign Up button

How do I sign in to my Submittable account?

- Go to the AAPS Rec & Ed Scholarship Submittable Sign In page
- You will see the application homepage
- Click the "Sign In" tab
- Enter the following information that you chose when you created the account:
 - Email Address
 - Password
- Click the blue "Sign In" button

- Be sure to double check that your email and password are correct. If you've lost or forgotten your password, <u>help is close at</u> hand

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How can I invite people to collaborate with me on a submission?

- Sign in to your account and select the application, you will be directed to the actual application. On this page, before you enter your information, you will see an option to Invite Collaborators.

Inviting Collaborators

- Click on Manage Collaborators. A Dialog box will appear, asking you to enter the email addresses of your collaborators. Enter those addresses, then click Invite
- Invited collaborators will receive an email, letting them know you've invited them to collaborate on a draft submission using Submittable

How do I submit my scholarship application?

- Sign in to your Submittable account
- Selected the application
- Fill out & provide all information
- Scroll to the bottom of the application
- Click the blue "Apply Here" button.



<u>I tried to submit my application, but it is not submitting. What should I do?</u>

- Scroll to the top of the page and review your application
- Look for any boxes that have Red writing underneath
 - Red writing indicates that the field needs to be filled out before submitting
- Fill in or edit the information
- Scroll to the bottom and click the blue "Apply Here" button

<u>I submitted a scholarship application, what are the next steps?</u>

- You will receive an email right away saying you submitted your scholarship application. If you did not receive an email, verify that you submitted your application
- Your application will be reviewed and processed in 5-7 business days. You will receive an email notification from AAPS Community Education and Recreation

How can I view a submission that I've made?

- Sign in to your Submittable account
- Click on Submissions at the top left of the page
- Your Submissions List is organized into tabs
- Locate the submission you want to view and click on the name of the submission
- You'll be directed to the submission's details

<u>How can I merge my Submittable accounts if</u> <u>I have more than one?</u>

 If you have created more than one Submittable account and you'd like to simplify things by merging them into one account with one username/password, our support team will be happy to help you do that. Find more information here: Merge Accounts

<u>Can I make edits to my application after I have submitted?</u>

- No, you will not be able to make edits on your own.
- You will need to email us at <u>scholarships@a2schools.org</u> to request to edit/update information on your application

How do I check the status of my application?

- Sign into your Submittable account
- You will be directed to your submissions page. If you are not directed there, click on your name in the top right corner
- You will see a list of your submissions and a colored status box to the left
- Statuses you may see:
 Accepted, Completed, Declined,
 In-Progress and Received

How can I update my personal information on my Submittable profile?

- Sign into your Submittable account
- Click on your name in the top right corner
- Under the Personal Account tab, click settings
- On the left side of the page you will see several subcategories
- Select "Update Profile Info"
- Edit your information
- Scroll to the bottom and click the "Update Your Profile" button

How can I download a copy of my application?

- In your submissions list, find the submission you want to download
- Click on the submission title
- Click the Download button in the upper right of the viewing box
- A .PDF summary of your submission will be downloaded to your computer

<u>How can I check to see if my scholarship is</u> active?

- Call our front desk staff at 734-994-2300 x0 during our normal business hours Monday-Friday from 8am-5pm
- Our staff will look up your scholarship in our system. Make sure to provide the Submitter's first and last name to staff

<u>How do I register for classes/activities/camps using a Rec & Ed Scholarship?</u>

- Wait to receive the scholarship award email and the enrollment period has opened for registration
- Call our office 734-994-2300 x 0 during our normal business hours (M-F from 8am-5pm) for assistance with registration
- We do save a specific number of spaces in all of our classes/camps, specifically for scholarship recipients

What benefits does the Rec & Ed Scholarship provide to an individual or family?

- Individuals/families approved under the scholarship will either be eligible for a 100% fee waiver or a 50% fee waiver based on the documentation provided
- Each approved individual or family member may use the scholarship fee waiver for 1 Rec & Ed class/ activity for our Fall, Winter and Spring terms & 2 classes/activities or 1 camp (youth only) & 1 class/activity for our Summer term

When should I apply for a scholarship?

- Early! Please submit your scholarship application and required documentation at least **10 business days** before any class/activity/camp registration is scheduled to begin
- There are numerous registrations throughout the year and it takes time to review and process each scholarship application. Please apply as early as possible to avoid registration delays

<u>Can I register for a class using my scholarship</u> <u>before the application has been processed?</u>

- No, Rec & Ed class/activity/camp registrations cannot be processed until we have an approved scholarship on file or full payment is received.
- Please note that we are not able to refund fees or retroactively apply this scholarship to previously enrolled classes, activities or camps

Are there any additional costs or exclusions for Rec & Ed classes/activities/camps?

- Scholarship recipients over 18 years of age are required to pay a minimum \$5.00 co-pay at the time of registration
- Some classes, activities or camps may indicate additional fees or specific scholarship co-pays
- Some of our classes, activities or camps may be excluded from the scholarship program or have a limited number of available spaces

Free/Reduced Lunch Rec & Ed Scholarship FAQs

Who is Eligible for the Free/Reduced Lunch Rec & Ed Scholarship Program?

- This Scholarship program is available to children enrolled in the Ann Arbor Public Schools who are currently participating in the AAPS Free/Reduced Lunch Program
- The scholarship award can also be applied to the parents/guardians of the children enrolled in AAPS and any preschool siblings

SPECIAL NOTE:

• If you have additional children who do not attend AAPS or who are not participating in the Free/Reduced lunch program or if you have additional adults or children over 18 who permanently reside within your household; you will need to complete a "Standard Scholarship" application if you would like scholarship coverage for these family members

What documentation do I need to provide?

 A copy of your AAPS Free/Reduced Lunch Letter

OR

• A completed **Share Form**

How Long Does this Rec & Ed Scholarship Last?

- Scholarships approved under this program will begin once approved by us and will expire on September 1 of the following school year
- This scholarship must be renewed each year

<u>Does this scholarship programs apply to the before & after school care (BAC) programs?</u>

- Yes! Based on the documentation you provide with your application, your child will be awarded a 25%, 50% or a 75% fee reduction of the "standard" fees for before and aftercare sessions.
- This will begin on the first day of the month following the scholarship approval date and will expire on September 1 of the next school year

Are there additional costs or exclusions for the before and after school program scholarship?

- Fee reductions do not apply to the enrollment fee, late payment or late pick-up fees
- Fees must be paid by the monthly deadline to maintain your child's enrollment and scholarship assistance
- Enrollment/registration fees, late pick-up fees, late payment fees are not covered under the EDP scholarship program

<u>Does this scholarship apply towards the Pay to Participate fees?</u>

Yes, this scholarship can be applied towards the PTP Sport Fee only.

Standard Rec & Ed Scholarship FAQs

Who is Eligible for the Free/Reduced Lunch Rec & Ed Scholarship Program?

 This Scholarship program is available to individuals and families who live within the boundaries of the Ann Arbor Public School District, have documented income/support that falls within specific HUD income guidelines and do not receive/qualify for the AAPS Free/Reduced Meal Program.

What documentation do I need to provide?

- Verification of your residency within the AAPS district by submitting a copy of your valid driver's license, a valid State ID or a current signed lease agreement
- Verification of your income/support by providing a copy of the following:
 - o Current year's Federal Tax forms
 - o W-2's
 - Two current pay checks
 - o Schedule C if self employed

SPECIAL NOTE:

- Based on your individual income/support situation, alternative or additional documentation may be required. The additional /alternative types of documentation are listed above
- If you are not currently working, you will need to provide information on how you are receiving support.

How Long Does this Rec & Ed Scholarship Last?

- Scholarships approved under this program will begin on the date the scholarship is approved and will expire on the first of the following month of the following year
- This scholarship must be renewed each year
